## RULES FOR TESTING:

- 1. CGC & CGCA Testing will complete one 2025 dog project for the 4-He'r.
- 2. Testing will be done on a "first come, first serve" basis.
- 3. If your dog has an AKC registered number (*Normal litter registration, Canine Partners, or Purebred Alternative Listing*), please bring it with you to register for testing. Don't worry if your dog does not have an AKC registered number. Come anyway.
- 4. Your dog must pass all 10 exercises to qualify for a title. Don't worry if you don't pass all 10 exercises. This testing is a "Pass" or "Need Training." This testing will tell you exactly on what you and your dog have to work on to pass the next given CGC or CGCA test.
- 5. Dogs will be kept on a leash and the leash will be in the owner's hand.
- 6. Keep your dogs 6 feet apart from your neighbor. We do not want a dog fight.
- 7. If your dog defecates, you will clean it up.
